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### Returning to School for the 2023 – 2024 Academic Year

As per our previous communication regarding the Department of Education's book scheme, I confirm again that all textbooks, workbooks and copies are covered by the grant and will be provided to students by the school.

There are certain costs not covered by the grant which we will have to charge a fee to cover. These items include the following;

- Pupil Personal Accident Insurance (24 hour cover for your child) - €7
- Photocopying and Arts/Craft Materials -€35
- Digital licences for curricular areas - €8

This is a total fee of €50 per child which can be paid via Aladdin Connect.
